<p>To improve pupil access to learning in the classroom</p> <p>Pupil confidence and engagement with learning in the classroom, especially with tasks that require perseverance.</p> <p>Pupils will engage with classroom learning with greater perseverance, and will begin to exhibit improved learning attitude in more independent work.</p>	<p>EEF research suggests that targeted 1-1 support from TAs shows moderate impact for high cost.
