

KS1 FOUNDATION SUBJECTS OVERVIEW— SUMMER 1st HALF-TERM 2021

English- Writing will focus on recounts of real events and of stories that the children will listen to, including fairy stories.

R and Y1 phonics: children will continue to review the letters and sounds already learnt in phase 3 and progress through phase 4. Y2 will focus more on spelling rules and grammar.

PE "Ball skills" -

Children will continue to develop their aiming, throwing and catching skills through observation, practical application and peer and self assessment.

Maths

Y1: Recognise and explore simple 3-D shapes, describe position, direction and movement, ordering numbers and objects., counting forwards and backwards in fives, telling the time., patterns.
Y2: Properties of 3D shapes and shape patterns, measuring volume, sequencing time, fractions, thirds, number problems and checking calculations.

Science - "why do we eat?" -

Children will talk about their food likes and dislikes, find out that food can be sorted into groups and that it is important to choose a balance of foods from each group to be healthy. They will also learn that other things contribute to being healthy such as exercise, keeping clean and sleep. Pupils will also learn about the different foods animals eat and about simple food chains.

Keeping Healthy



RE— Buddhism -

Children will learn about the life of Buddha and consider why he was considered a very special person. They will listen to some of the stories the Buddha told to teach people how to behave. Children will reflect on their own feelings, ideas and values and be aware of the experiences and feelings of others.

DT/Art — "Healthy eating"

This unit develops children's familiarity with different fruits and vegetables, starting with fruit and vegetable identification and learning how to chop, peel or grate them to prepare them. They will look at the work of the artist Arcimboldo and design a healthy fruit/veg collage in a similar way, It links with PHSE and well-being.

FRENCH

will learn and use basic vocabulary and phrases relating to the seasons and weather through games, stories and songs which will lay the foundations for achievements against the language objectives in the KS2 language framework.

Geography-

will link with PHSE in helping children understand how to keep safe in different situations, from keeping safe in the sun and on the beach, to crossing the road and what to do to keep safe if you ever get lost or separated from the people you are with when out and about.

Reception children will be taught alongside Y1/Y2 children but will focus on the Early Learning Goals which are interrelated and overlap and can take place in any area of the above curriculum areas.
